修課特殊規定：

本系必修共 51 學分，校定通識 28 學分，體育必修課 4 學分，選修 45 學分。

多修習之必修課程可採計為選修學分，學程、輔系、雙主修學分亦可列入選修。

本系必修（含群修）課程以修習本系開設之課程為原則，如因特殊原因擬修習他系科目名稱、學分數及學期數相同或學分數、學期數較多之相同名稱科目時，修習前需經本系同意，並依本表規定採計學分。

學生修習本表所列單學期相同科目名稱之學年課時，需修習期滿並及格，始得依本表採計學分，下學期科目學分認定為選修學分。

本系開設之必修科目不收外系生（區域研究例外），輔系及雙主修學生不在此限。

全民國防教育軍事訓練及體育選修課不採計為本系畢業學分。

依本校「外國學生入學招生規定」第四條規定，外國學生畢業前須通過「華語文能力測驗」基礎級檢定，未通過者應自費修習本校華語特別班四學期（每學期一門）且及格。

Specific Regulations：

1. Students of diplomacy major should complete 51 required credits, 28 general education credits, 4 physical education credits, and 45 elective credits. Credits that exceed 51 required ones will be recognized as electives. The department recognizes credits acquired through double major, minors, and credits programs as electives.
2. Students should take the required courses and required elective courses offered by the Department of Diplomacy. A student should obtain approval in advance if the student has special reasons to take the required courses from other departments. Such courses should bear the same name with the required courses in our department, and the credit hours should be the same or above. Once approved, the course in question will be recognized as the required course of the Department of Diplomacy. The department will only approve the credits that are listed on our required courses list. If the out-of-department course is a two-semester course and our required course only has one semester, the student should complete the course for two semesters. The department will only count the first semester as required credits. The credits of the second semester will be recognized as electives.
3. With the exception of Regional Studies (required elective course), the department will not offer the required courses to non-Diplomacy major students. This restriction does not apply to students with double major and/or minor of the Department of Diplomacy.
4. Defense education and military training elective credits and physical education elective credits do not count toward the major in Department of Diplomacy.
5. According to the "NCCU Admission Guidelines for International Students", international students are required to pass the Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) at Level 2 before graduation. If students fail to acquire the certificate at the required level, they will have to take and pass four semesters of NCCU Mandarin Special Course (one course per semester) at their own expense before graduation.
